SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST - YEAR A June 18th 2017

Dear Parishioners,

'Christ is our food and drink. Just as in human life we need food and drink so we need Christ to sustain us in our spiritual lives. He feeds us with Himself just as God fed the Jews with manna in the wilderness. Our sharing of the one Body and Blood of Christ means that we share with each other Christ's eternal life.'(Pope Saint John Sunday Missal.)

The baptismal preparation evenings for July will take place on Thursday 6th July and Thursday 13th July at 8pm in the Presbytery. All are welcome.

Please pray also for our children of Year 3 at St Augustine's who will be making their First Holy Communion next Saturday at 2.30pm. Also please pray for our Confirmand who will be Confirmed on Wednesday 28th June at 7pm by Bishop Robert Byrne.

In preparation for the Mass of Confirmation, we are arranging a Penance Service on Wednesday 21st June at 7pm for those of our young Parishioners who are able to attend.

Alongside the Penance Service there will be a Meeting for the Parents of those being Confirmed which will be led by Deacon Kevin. This will be held in the Parish Hall. There will be free car parking in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park for this Meeting.

This weekend has been designated as this year's 'Day for Life'-This year's Day for Life is particularly significant as it is 50 years since the 1967 Abortion Act was passed in England, Scotland and Wales. This provides us with an opportunity to pray for and remember all lives lost before birth and to offer practical and emotional support to women and men who are worried and concerned about an unexpected pregnancy. For those who have had an abortion, this anniversary year is a reminder that 50years on,' there is no sin that God's mercy cannot reach and wipe away when it finds a repentant heart seeking to be reconciled with the Father.'(Pope Francis, Apostolic Letter, Misericordia et Misere, 12) There will be a second collection which will go to the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other Church- supported life activities.
