Message of Pope Francis to celebrate 51st World Day of Peace 'Heartfelt good wishes for peace Peace to all people and to all nations on earth! Peace, which the angels proclaimed to the shepherds on Christmas night is a profound aspiration for everyone, for each individual and all peoples, and especially for those who most keenly suffer its absence. Among these whom I constantly keep in my thoughts and prayers, I would once again mention the over 250 million migrants worldwide, of whom 22.5 million are refugees. Pope Benedict XVI, my beloved predecessor, spoke of them as "men and women, children, young and elderly people, who are searching for somewhere to live in peace." In order to find that peace, they are willing to risk their lives on a journey that is often long and perilous, to endure hardships and suffering, and to encounter fences and walls built to keep them far from their goal. In a spirit of compassion, let us embrace all those fleeing from war and hunger, or forced by discrimination, persecution, poverty and environmental degradation to leave their homelands. We are thinking of having a nostalgic disco in the parish hall, to raise funds for Aid to the Church in Need. The music (1960s, '70s, & '80s) would be for example, The Electric Light Orchestra, Status Quo, Roy Orbison, various 'top-notch' Motown stars, and Abba. We want people to 're-live' their youthful memories; so the plan is for a dance, not a 'just sit and listen' night. Admittance free; donations on departure. There is a safety-limit of 50, so late-comers might be excluded. After the Saturday and Sunday Masses on 27th/28th January and 3rd/4th February you will be invited to put your names on a list as 'likely to come' (but without commitment). If too few show interest, the event will not go ahead. Please support it.
