Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ 3rd June 2018

Dear Parishioners,

'This is My Body. This is My Blood. Christ is our high Priest who constantly makes intercession for us. He offers himself to his Father as an atonement for our sins and establishes a new covenant or pact with God which is his own body and blood. This is far greater than the old Jewish sacrifice of goats and bull calves. It wins for us the eternal inheritance, which we have been promised. (Pope Saint John Sunday Missal.)

The baptismal preparation evening for June will take place on Thursday 21st June at 8pm in the Presbytery. All are welcome.

The dates for First Holy Communion are: Sunday 10th June during the 11am Mass for those not attending a Catholic School ; and Saturday 16th June at 3pm for our Year 3 of Saint Augustine's.

The date of Confirmation is Wednesday 27th June at 7pm with Archbishop Bernard.
