READER: We remember all who are sick or suffering, homeless or housebound, that they will know the love of Christ in their lives. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We ask that the dignity of human life will be protected by law throughout our country. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.
