THE CRIB- St Francis of Assisi started it all in the 13th century in the little town of Greccio 40 miles north of Roman. But first, he had asked the Pope, who thought it was a great idea. So on Christmas Eve, 1223 Fr Francis and Friar John built the first Crib. Legend has it that when he sang the Gospel, at the words 'and they laid him in a manger' he knelt down to meditate on the mystery of the Incarnation- God becoming one of us- and at that moment there appeared in his arms a child surrounded by a brilliant light. From then on, one of the most important parts of Christmas is making the Crib- for our homes and in churches. It is the outward sign of welcoming Jesus into our lives at Christmas time.
