**PRIEST:** Dear Lord, we remember you are the living bread, you nourish us beyond all else. You remain in us, and we in you. Hear our prayers we bring before you.

We especially think of those that are starting school for the first time, those that are moving up to a new school or college. May their new adventures be filled with new friends and exciting opportunities. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

**READER:** We pray for our own church community; may we grow together in faith and compassion. We give thanks to our clergy that inspire us weekly on our journey with God.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

**READER:** We pray for those caught up in the school shooting in a church in Minneapolis this week, and for the wider community affected. We ask the Holy Spirit to draw near to them in their shock and grief.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response Lord graciously hear us.

**READER:** We pray for those that feel uncertain, worried, and unsure of their future. May they be guided to live a full life, steered by God, and to accept the advice of good counsellors.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We pray that those touched by shadows of bereavement, may feel themselves close to their dear ones, through him whose light even death could not overcome.
