PRIEST: As we eagerly await the coming of the Son of Man, let us turn in confidence to God the Father almighty and implore his mercy for ourselves and the whole world.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We pray that those touched by shadows of bereavement, may feel themselves close to their dear ones, through him whose light even death could not overcome.
